#### **HOW DOES GREENCLEAN GRANULAR WORK?**

GreenClean is a granular algaecide with an activated peroxygen chemistry that works through a powerful oxidation reaction to break down algae cells on contact. An added benefit, the process releases oxygen into the water as it works to eliminate algae.

#### **HOW DO I APPLY GREENCLEAN?**

Simply scatter the granules evenly over the algae infested area. You do not need to mix the granules into solution first. GreenClean can be made into a liquid solution but the liquid solution will not sink to the bottom to control algae growing in deeper areas. If making a solution for liquid applications, use it immediately for best results.

#### **HOW MUCH GREENCLEAN DO I APPLY?**

The general rule of thumb for string algae is 1 cup of GreenClean per 1000-gallons of water. GreenClean can also be used as a spot treatment where necessary.

#### **I HAVE FISH IN MY POND; CAN I USE GREENCLEAN?**

GreenClean will not harm fish or aquatic life. GreenClean once diluted in water is non-harmful to animals such as birds, bees, and pets.

#### **DOES GREENCLEAN GET RID OF GREEN WATER?**

Green water is a sign of new pond syndrome. Use GreenClean at low rates and remember that eliminating green water takes time. Apply three tablespoons per 1000-gallons once a week in conjunction with biological products and a bit of patience. The species that is generally the culprit of green water is a species of green planktonic algae, and is very difficult to control with a one-time, high-rate treatment of GreenClean. Frequent, small applications are the key to eliminating green water. Also apply GreenClean at frequent, very low rates to combat blue-green planktonic algae.

#### **CAN I USE GREENCLEAN ON MY WATERFALL?**

GreenClean is excellent for treating waterfalls. GreenClean is a contact algaecide, and the granules need to make contact with the algae to be effective. Our recommendation for treating waterfalls is to turn the pumps off, apply GreenClean to the algae, and then turn them back on after twenty minutes. In the case of a vertical tank wall this can pose some difficulties, and it may require multiple applications or draining down the water level so that GreenClean can be applied directly to the algae.

#### **CAN I USE GREENCLEAN ON INSIDE WATER FEATURES?**

If using indoors, it should be noted that GreenClean is a photo-enhanced chemical and will work better under high light or in sunny conditions. GreenClean will also work better in warmer waters rather than in cold waters.

#### **WILL GREENCLEAN AFFECT THE pH LEVEL?**

GreenClean will raise the pH in a water garden up to 1 pH unit. Although this will come back down on its own within about a week, if GreenClean is applied more often than once a month, users should monitor for pH levels.

#### **IS GREENCLEAN ONLY FOR WATER?**

GreenClean can be used on hard surfaces to remove tough algae stains. Use on patio furniture, walk ways, decks, siding, birdbaths, and other surfaces that are prone to algae growth. See label directions for full details
